Thank you for your interest in recognizing a veteran on the Holdrege Veterans Memorial an ongoing way to celebrate those who have served our country bravely.

To have a name engraved on the memorial, there are required documents that must be filled out completely and returned to the Phelps County Community Foundation along with a \$200 donation. Enclosed in this packet are the two for PVD and a Verification of Service

Along with the completed documents, the committee is also requiring a copy of the veteran's honorable discharge papers, which include a DD214 or VA Form 53-557, Veterans Service Officer. This is to ensure that only veterans' names appear on the memorial.

Please note that when you are filling out both documents, all the contact information listed MUST be for the individual arranging for the name(s) to be engraved on the memorial.

Donations to the Holdrege Veterans Memorial must be made payable to the Phelps County Community Foundation with Veterans Memorial listed in the memo section. To make an online donation visit www.phelpsfoundation.org, click on "Donate Today" and select "Holdrege Veterans Memorial." The forms are available with the VSO or PCCF.

The Holdrege Veterans Memorial Committee has established July 15th as the deadline for names to be submitted for inclusion on the memorial. If the required documents are submitted after that deadline, the veteran's name will be engraved on the memorial the following year. Names will only be added to the memorial once a year ahead of Veterans Day.

HOLDREGE VETERANS MEMORIAL

Verification of Service Agreement

One of the requirements to have a name placed on the Holdrege Veterans Memorial is to have that individual's service verified. All individuals' names being placed on this memorial must meet the following requirements:

1. Must be a veteran of the armed forces (see definition below)
2. Veteran must have received an Honorable Discharge
3. Veteran must have served at least 1 day of active duty (NOT for training)
4. Must be able to provide either the DD214 or VA Form 53-55 for verification purposes

Title 38 of the Code of Federal Regulations defines a veteran as "a person who served in the active military, naval, or air service and who was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable."

For National Guard or Reservists, they are required to have been called to active duty, Title 10 Orders, and have completed the tour of duty with an Honorable Discharge. Basic Training, Advanced Training, summer camps, and weekend drills do not count as active duty.

I agree to provide either the DD214 or VA Form 53-55 for verification of service. (Please attach a copy to this document).

I understand that this gift is considered irrevocable and is subject to Phelps County Community Foundation control. If it is found that the individual being recommended for inclusion on the Holdrege Veterans Memorial does not meet the above requirements, you will be notified and your donation will remain in the Holdrege Veterans Memorial Fund, held by PCCF. All funds will be used for initial construction, future expansion, and maintenance of the Holdrege Veterans Memorial.

I understand that if the required documents are turned in after July 15th the name being submitted will be engraved on the memorial the following year. Names will only be added the the Holdrege Veterans Memorial once a year ahead of Veterans Day.
